Gospel Reflection: Saint John Chrysostom offers this reflection on today's Gospel, the Parable of the Vineyard [Matthew 21:33-42]: "Observe the great care that the owner took with this place and the extraordinary hardness of the people. He himself did the work the tenants should have done. It was he who planted a vineyard, and set a hedge around it, and dug a wine press in it and built a tower. He left little for them to do. All they had to do was take care of what was there and to preserve what was given to them. Nothing was left undone but all accomplished. But they made little effort to be productive, even after they had enjoyed such great blessings from him. Then he 'went into a far country.' He was patient with them. He did not keep a close account of their sins. The meaning of "going into a far country" is God's great patience."
