Pastor's Notebook: 'Open unto me, 0 Giver of Life, the gates of repentance' sings the Church at matins for the first of the four Sundays which prepare us for Lent. Indeed, this Sunday could be thought of as a gate: a gate through which we enter the sacred period which leads us on to Easter; a gate which opens into that atmosphere of repentance, to that life of repentance which Lent should bring to each one of us. But we must remember that the word "penitence" or "repentance" is a translation of the Greek gospel term "metanoia": and that this means 'change of heart or mind'. Much more is involved than the observance of some kind of outward repentance. What is asked of us is a deep inner change, renewal, conversion.

"At matins, the Church sums up the gospel parable and formulates the central thought for this Sunday thus: 'Lord, who reproached the Pharisee with justifying himself and taking pride in his actions; You who justified the publican when he approached you humbly, seeking with groans pardon for his sins — for you did not come near to arrogant thoughts nor turn Yourself away from a contrite heart. Because of this, we also humbly kneel before You, O You who have suffered for us. Grant us Your pardon and Your great mercy'."
