<u>Mysteries of Christian Initiation</u>: There is to be **preparatory instruction** for parents and godparents prior to the celebration of the **Mysteries of Christian Initiation** – **Baptism, Chrismation,** and **Eucharist**. The **Pre-Cana Program** offered by the Archeparchy in the spring of each year is a *required* part of the marriage preparation for all couples.
