<u>Mysteries of Christian Initiation</u>: There is to be preparatory instruction for parents and godparents prior to the celebration of the <u>Mysteries of Christian Initiation</u> – <u>Baptism</u>, <u>Chrismation</u>, and <u>Eucharist</u>.
