**Pastor's Notebook:** Today, the Sunday of Meatfare, is most identified with the dramatic and vivid Gospel scene of the final judgment. Here we encounter Christ, coming in glory, as the "King" who separates sheep from goats. In one respect, the scene is highly symbolic in details and references. Even so, it is clear and compelling in its message that we encounter Christ in these "least of my brethren". These are the hungry, thirsty, naked, strangers, the ill, and the prisoners who appear of no account, easily disregarded.

It is compassion and love shown to these which in reality is expressed to Christ. This awareness is to be especially important in our preparation for the season of the Great Fast which soon begins.

**Adult Education/Catechesis:** The Great Fast is an opportunity to build up and strengthen our faith by formation and instruction and other ways to deepen our faith. Reading, first and foremost the Scriptures and other spiritual reading are always valuable.

There can also be sessions for education and enrichment. Please let Father Jim know if you have suggestions and an interest in such opportunities for the Great Fast. This would be helpful in planning such opportunities.

<u>Mysteries of Christian Initiation</u>: There is to be **preparatory instruction** for parents and godparents prior to the celebration of the **Mysteries of Christian Initiation** – **Baptism, Chrismation,** and **Eucharist**.
