Prayerful best wishes for a joyful celebration of Pascha—the Resurrection of our Lord.

• We share the greeting *"Christ is risen!"*, *"Indeed He is risen!"* from now until Ascension, which is derived from the greeting of the disciples [Luke 24:34].

• **During Bright Week** there is <u>no fasting</u>. **Through the fifty days** from Pascha [Sunday of the Resurrection] until Pentecost, there is <u>no kneeling</u> at any time of prayer.

• On **Bright Monday**, there is a procession which stops at the four sides of the church, and at each side we read the accounts of the resurrection from each of the four Gospels.
