100th Anniversary—Byzantine Ruthenian Church: The Centennial of the Byzantine Catholic Ruthenian Exarchate; and the *Golden Jubilee* of the dedication of the Byzantine Ruthenian Chapel, are being commemorated at a *Jubilee Weekend*, Saturday, October 12 and Sunday, October 13 at the Byzantine Ruthenian Chapel, National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington; and at Epiphany of our Lord Byzantine Catholic Church in Annandale, Virginia.

The appointment of Bishop Basil Takach as the first Bishop for the Ruthenians in the United States was in 1924. In his First Pastoral Letter, sent from Uniontown, Pennsylvania, on September 30, 1924, Bishop Basil's first words to the clergy and Christ's Faithful in the United States were about love and obedience. He faced the challenges of organizing our church life amid competing interests:

"Do you wish to make success in a short time? Follow me, work with me. As my message here in the land of free America, which comes to life in the union of good deeds, love and obedience will be a fruitful success on your part only through your good deeded love and obedience can be accomplished.

"Love and obedience are the vivifying esential elements of building the Kingdom of God in the Church of Christ upon earth." [First Pastoral Letter, 1924, Bishop Basil Takach]
