Feast of the Birth of the Theotokos: The Church invites us today to join the parents of the Mother of God, Joachim and Anne, and Adam and Eve, to celebrate the prelude of universal joy and the first fruits of our salvation. Through poetical hymns written with dogmatic precision, the Divine Liturgy leads us to meditate on Mary, "Predestined before all ages, the Immaculate". Her birth marks the beginning of the work of redemption, since Mary was to be the Mother of God.

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross: A tradition well established in the sixth century relates that Helen, mother of Emperor Constantine the Great, discovered near Golgotha the three crosses on which Christ and the two thieves had been crucified. Bishop Macarios identified the true Cross of Christ as the one whose touch immediately returned a dying woman to perfect health
