Pre-Lenten Sundays: The journey of these *Pre-Lenten Sundays,* becomes familiar to us, a yearly sequence of gradual preparation for the Great Fast. At the same time it is always new, as each year the circumstances in our own life and our awareness of our faith are distinct and vary.

Today, this Sunday of the *Publican and Pharisee* highlights the value and meaning of humility in this process of preparation. In his classic book, <u>Great Lent</u>, Father Alexander Schmemann writes of a certain paradox involved here.

Actually, God himself is humble. Commonly, humility and glory are seen as opposite, as if humility is an indication of some flow or deficiency. Rather, all that is perfect, beautiful, and good is at the same time naturally humble. Because of its perfection, it has no need of "publicity" external glory or "showing off".

Christ is the divine humility incarnate. We learn humility by contemplating Christi who said, "Learn from me, for I am meek and humble in heart." [Matthew 11:29]
